## Organizing authority

Union-Yacht-Club Attersee (UYCAS) in the name of the Austrian Sailing Federation and the Upper Austrian Sailing Federation

## Venue

Lake Attersee

## Rules

The event will be governed by the rules defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Additional the prescriptions of the Austrian Sailing Federation (OeSV), the standard sailing instructions of the OeSV, the sailing instructions of the UYCAS and this notice of race (NoR).

The notation [DP] in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

All participants must wear personal flotation devices. If the class rules do not prescribe higher standards, ISO standard 12402-5 (or equivalent) is the minimum requirement for personal flotation devices. The use of inflatable flotation devices (automatic vests) is permitted only if expressly permitted in the applicable class rules.

The anti-doping rules of World Sailing and the Austrian Anti-Doping-Bundesgesetz shall apply. For doping suspended or blocked athletes and caregivers are not admitted to participate in the regatta.

Depending on the current situation of the Covid-19 pandemic, there may be special provisions for the event. As far as they concern the eligibility to participate (e.g. negative Covid-19-Test required), these will then be published as timely as possible as an attachment to this notice of race. As far as they concern the behavior at the event (e.g. distances, wearing a mask), these are published as “Covid-19 provisions” on the notice board and have the status of a rule in the sense of the WRS. [DP]

## Advertising

Boats may be obliged to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizer [DP].

# Contender – Austrian and Upper Austrian Championship

## Eligibility

International open for all boats of the Contender Class, registered in the register of yachts in a club affiliated to World Sailing. Boats shall conform to the class rules. Each competitor must hold a third party liability insurance. Helmsmen shall be members of a club affiliated to their national authority or shall be individual members of their national authority.

Helmsmen are required to possess a sailing license “OeSV Junior-Regattalizenz”, a license “Bfa-Binnen” issued by the Austrian Federation, a “Bodensee-Schifferpatent” or must possess a sailing license from their national authority (if any).

A boat is only eligible if she has completed the registration and all crew members have signed the disclaimer (liability, images, data).

## Entry closing date

There is a minimum of 15 entries at entry closing date (August 5th, 2022). In case there are less than 15 boats the regatta may be cancelled. If the regatta takes place and there are enough races, the Austrian title will be given irrespective of the number of starters.

# Contender – Austrian and Upper Austrian Championship

## Registration

Wednesday, August 17th, 2022, 10:00 am to 01:00 pm, 03:00 pm to 06:00 pm and Thursday, August 18th, 2022, 08:00 to 10:00 am:

Each competitor shall provide at the registration office the measurement certificate of the boat, a confirmation / written proof of third party liability insurance of € 1.500.000,-, a membership card of their national federation and class organization and a race license (if any provided by the National Authority).

## Equipment-inspection

Each boat shall produce or verify the existence of a valid measurement certificate on Wednesday, August 17th, 2022, 10:00 am to 01:00 pm, 03:00 pm to 06:00 pm and Thursday, August 18th, 2022, 08:00 to 10:00 am.

Boats may be inspected at any time.

## 1st warning signal

Thursday, August 18th, 2022, 12:00 am

## Last warning signal

Saturday, August 20th, 2022, 03:00 pm

## Sailing instructions

Sailing instructions are available at the registration.

## Courses

Courses according ICA Championship Rules with the possibility of a leeward finish will be sailed. Courses and description of marks will be defined in the sailing instructions.

## Penalty system

Appendix 'P' will apply with the change, that rule P2.3 will not apply. Rule P2.2 is changed so that it will apply to any penalty after the first one.

## Scoring

8 races with 1 discard are scheduled. If less than 5 races are completed there will be no discard. 4 completed races are required to constitute the Austrian Championship. 2 completed races are required to constitute the Upper Austrian Championship. No more than 4 races will be sailed per day.

## Berthing

All boats have to be placed on land at the designated places [DP].

## Radio communication

Except in case of emergency a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data communication that is not available to all boats [DP].

<b>Insurance</b>	Each competitor must hold a third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of € 1.500.000,- per event, or an equivalent.
<b>Support person vessels</b>	<p>All coach/support person vessels shall be registered with the organizing authority no later than July 15th, 2022 (a late registration is not possible) and will be required to comply with local legislation and ‘Event Support Team Regulations’ that will be published on the official website.</p> <p>The organizing authority may refuse registrations and accept later registrations at their sole discretion.</p> <p>Coach/support person vessels shall be insured with a valid and for the racing area suitable third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 3,000,000 EUR per incident or the equivalent.</p>

# Liability, Images, Data: The clauses, that apply to all regattas



## General

Competitors commit with their entry and/or participation to follow the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the rules of good seamanship and any other valid rules for this event as well as the regulations of Sailing Federations and the legal standards and participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk in accordance with RRS 3 and accepting the Notice of Race.

The organizing authority, its associates and appointees accept no responsibility for any damage – howsoever caused – ashore and afloat, for example those of crew, material and financial loss, as far as permitted by applicable law. This exclusion of liability applies to the occurrence of damage before, during and after the event, but not (a) in the event of wilful intent or gross negligence, (b) for personal injury in the event of gross negligence, (c) for personal injury if, as an exception, § 6 / 1 / 9 KSchG would apply.

To the same extent, each participant waives his claims for damages against all persons who (a) are responsible for the implementation of the regatta (e.g. race director) or as referee and / or (b) who assist the organizer at his request or order.

The onus of presentation and the burden of proof in terms of the occurrence of damages is incumbent upon the competitors.

The organizing authority excludes liability for lost property or damage caused by third parties as well as unpredictable or unusual damage.

## Recordings in sound and vision

By registering and/or participating, all participating persons declare that they agree that pictures and sound recordings of them and their boats/material may be taken and used for media coverage of the event and for their - also future - application, as well as for promoting the purposes of the organizing clubs may be published indefinitely.

## Data

By registering and / or participating, all participants declare that they agree that the personal data they provide may be stored, used and passed on to higher-level sports organizations in the context of the organizational implementation of the event.

## Minors

Declarations for under-age competitors have to be signed additionally by their legal representative or by a representative, who is authorized in writing for this particular case.

## Other

The organisation of the event begins well in advance. Refunds of entry fee and travel expenses will not be provided. In exceptional cases (parts of) the entry fee (amounting to saved expenses) might be refunded -not in cases of force majeure.

Changes of the Notice of Race or other rules (eg sailing instructions) remain reserved, but will be announced in time.

All prizes (especially property and memory prizes) expire, if they are not taken during the prize giving ceremony.

The law of the Republic of Austria applies to questions that are not subject to the autonomy of the sport (association). The place of jurisdiction is the locally and factually competent court for Attersee am Attersee.
